## Job Description Classroom Teacher Malvern Wyche C of E Primary School

- 1. Teaching the full age and subject range of the primary curriculum.
- 2. Abiding by and upholding the teacher standards.
- 3. Being accountable for the progress and attainment of a class of primary-age pupils.
- 4. Organising the classroom and learning resources and creating displays to encourage a safe and stimulating learning environment.
- 5. Planning, preparing and presenting inclusive lessons that challenge all learners and groups of learners and enable them to make progress.
- 6. Promoting and maintaining high standards of behaviour.
- 7. Taking an active and informed role in the safeguarding of children and child protection.
- 8. Giving verbal and written feedback work to facilitate pupil progress.
- 9. Assessing, recording and tracking pupil progress including engaging in internal and external moderation and statutory assessments.
- 10. Providing feedback to parents and carers on a pupil's progress at parents' evenings and other meetings.
- 11. Coordinating activities and resources within a specific area of the curriculum, and supporting colleagues in the delivery of this specialist area.
- 12. Collaborating with other member of staff in planning, assessment and organisation.
- 13. Engaging with monitoring and performance management including pupil progress meetings.
- 14. Line managing a classroom teaching assistant.
- 15. Keeping up to date with changes and developments in teaching, learning, safeguarding and curriculum.
- 16. Organising and taking part in school events, outings and activities, which may take place at weekends or in the evening.
- 17. Liaising with and supporting colleagues and working flexibly.
- 18. Working with parents and school governors to maximise involvement in the school and the development of resources for the school.
- 19. Meeting with other professionals such as education welfare officers, social workers and educational psychologists, where required.
